5 Extreme Methods of Treatment For Bleeding Hemorrhoids

The curse of hemorrhoids often occurs when having to try too hard on the toilet. It's a swollen section of skin and blood vessels in the vicinity of your anus. You should consider [home remedies for hemorrhoids](#) to stop this fast.

They usually occur in and around the external opening of the rectum. They are highly innervated and sensitive and are also at risk for thrombosis. Internal hemorrhoids occur above the pectinate or dentate line in the anal canal.

They are covered by a mucous membrane. The internal hemorrhoid is graded to help with the selection of a treatment plan. Discover [how to treat hemorrhoids](#) and save yourself a lot of hardship.

The healing is then provided according to the grade. Severity of the condition depends on the size of the hemorrhoid, how far it distends on the in and outside of your anal cavity.

One of the most common indicators that you have internal hemorrhoids can be bleeding from your anus. Hemorrhoids can leak fresh red blood, whether located externally or internally. Internal hemorrhoids regularly presents with fresh blood in your stool. Reasons for bleeding internal hemorrhoids.

Hemorrhoids can develop from any common sources of pressure like

- a) Not getting enough roughage and water making you constipated resulting in too much effort when defecating.
- b) Diarrhea, where the expulsion of loose stools is continuous.
- c) Spending too much time standing or sitting with no exercise
- d) Obesity
- e) Lifting very heavy weights or objects f) Pregnancy and childbirth.

How to deal with bleeding internal hemorrhoids a) See your doctor without fail. If you have been suffering from bleeding internal hemorrhoids then inform him if your bleeding is not stopping. If you are not aware of why you are bleeding then go for a check up as more than often anal fissure is mistaken for bleeding internal hemorrhoids. b) Wipe yourself with clean wet toilet paper. Wetting the paper makes it softer. c) Ask for emergency care if you notice large amounts of rectal bleeding along with dizziness or faintness.

Treatment for bleeding internal hemorrhoids if the bleeding is not stopping with prescribed medicines the doctor may recommend

- a) Rubber band ligation- Here one or two tiny rubber bands around the base of an internal hemorrhoid to cut off its circulation and the hemorrhoid falls off.
- b) Sclerotherapy- Is when a chemical solution gets injected into the area around the swollen blood vessels with the aim to shrink it.
- c) Laser treatment- A burst of infrared light can cut off flow to small, bleeding, internal hemorrhoids.
- d) Hemorrhoidectomy- This is the last resource if other procedures fail.

In this instance surgery is performed using a local anesthetic combined with sedation, you are normally kept overnight for observation.
