Most of the muscles that manipulate TMJ are composed of lateral pterygoid, medial pterygoid and buccinators just to name a few, wherein these also have an impact as how our necks, shoulders and backs function.

A sign of having TMJ may include arthritis, due to the teeth gnashing itself at nighttime. When the disk gets put out of place, then that becomes another source. A disk not in the right position has the capability of making ticking sounds and puts the mouth in difficulty when it moves.

The break in the disk may make an unusual sound when the joint is in movement. Teeth grinding may also cause the signals to appear like the minor disturbance in the tendons and joint capsule.
