Unfortunately there is a pain component linked to toenail fungus, and the more severe it becomes the more pain there is. What makes it challenging to see straightaway is the fact that the fungus starts to amass and develop underneath the nail. What takes place is the fungus starts metabolizing the toenail because it is consuming the keratin protein contained in the toenail. It's possible that toenail fungus could thrive in lighter environments, like fingernails, but it does best underneath toenails because of the lower light. You can help prevent the infection from happening by taking good care of your nails, and avoid wearing too tight shoes day in and day out. The best growth conditions can come about as a consequence of a skin pH that is outside of what is normal.

The most effective way to stop the outgrowth of this fungus is by simple good hygiene. But it is important to realize that the fungus can spread from others directly to you or from wet community conditions.
