The majority will have to cope with haemorrhoids one or more times in their life. The application of hemorrhoidal cream is the following step for anyone that finds the baths are just not doing enough. This cream will be applied to the area affected and should provide at least a bit of relief. Preparation-H is the most famous but there are others as well, including Tronolane and Scheriproct and each works in identical basic way so it actually doesn't matter if you decide to choose a better known brand or no name. These creams are meant to be applied directly to the areas affected and may be employed numerous times daily.

Only in the most significant cases is surgery ever considered. While this should be thought about as a last resort, it's required in some situations. Surgery is safe and there aren't many risks and complications but because it is aggressive it shouldn't be turned to unless the patient is totally going to take advantage of it.
