# How To Spot Quality Coffee Beans

Selecting coffee beans can be confusing since there are a lot of coffee bean varieties you could choose from. You can try them all actually to find out your ultimate choice but before buying coffee beans, you need to make sure that they are of good quality.

There are a lot of things you should look for in coffee beans if you don't want to end up sipping a bland and dull coffee in the morning. Opt for coffee beans that are fresh-looking, well-shaped and smell good at your gourmet or specialty shop.

Freshly roasted and freshly grinded coffee beans make an excellent coffee, [Coffee Makers](#) would all agree. To find out if coffee beans are indeed freshly roasted, ask the salesperson of the specialty store and get straight answer. As per coffee beans from supermarket, you may just check the bottom of their packaging to know when the date they were roasted.

Your coffee maker should have a grinder, just like [Jura Capresso Z7 Espresso Machine](#), so you can grind your coffee beans at home. If you don't have a grinder at home, you are stuck with pre-ground coffee. Check the packaging of it first so you'll know when the coffee beans have been packed. The packaging should have a one-way valve wherein coffee gasses and carbon dioxide can escape from it, while at the same, keeping the air from coming inside the bag. Fresh beans are in good shape and look shiny. Substandard coffee beans can be easily spotted because they are the ones which have broken off edges or splinters in the beans. If the beans smell good and look appetizing, then you are good to go.

After purchasing the beans, put them in a concealed container where air can't come in so that they will remain fresh as long as possible. Just grind them for immediate use. Speaking of grinding, have your coffee beans grinded by a reliable coffee machine with grinder like Jura Capresso Z7 Espresso Machine.
