How To Understand The Symptoms of Acid Reflux

It is definitely to your benefit to have this symptom diagnosed by a physician. You don't want to make the mistake of thinking it is something worse than just a bit of heartburn.

Having trouble swallowing is another symptom of acid reflux. This can happen due to the muscles in your throat and esophagus constricting from too much acid in your stomach. Usually trouble swallowing is mistaken for a sign of an allergic reaction to something. Every so often, this is a sign of an impending acid reflux attack. Once diagnosed you can stave off an attack by taking your medication at this first sign. If you haven't talked to your doctor yet, be sure to mention this to him next time. You will get back to regular life sooner, the sooner you are diagnosed.

Occasionally, people who have to endure acid reflux feel something called a "wet burp." The "wet burp" is one of the nastier acid reflux symptoms. This is when you get the sensation that you're going to burp and when you actually do burp, a bit of bile or stomach acid makes its way up through your esophagus and into your mouth. This is unlike vomiting, from the perception that you are able to swallow the bile back down again. The lack of ferocity in the backup also makes this different from vomiting. At the same time, the "wet burp" is classified as an indicator called "regurgitation." Acid reflux is not an amusing illness to have. Thankfully, with the right medications and treatments, you can lead a perfectly normal life and keep your symptoms at bay.
